as you shall from time to time receive from me or any other your Superior Officer, according to Law.

GIVEN under my Hand and Office Seal at Arms, at *York* _____ this *Fifth* _____ Day of
August _____ in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and *Twenty* _____ and in the
First _____ year of His Majesty's Reign.
